INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Each application received will be assessed according to English language and academic level as well as age. Candidates who do not meet the criteria for direct entry may be made a conditional offer of a place with a requirement to complete a school preparation program.

The College will take into consideration the following factors when assessing applications:

1. English Language Level (evidence required)

a) Students must meet the minimum level of English language proficiency for entry into:

(i) **International Primary Years Course (010139J)**

Australian Education Assessment Services (AEAS) Test and/or National Languages & Literacy Institute of Australia (NLLIA) Primary Bandscale Test: Overall Level 4 [Years 4 & 5]; Level 5 [Year 6]

(ii) **Junior Secondary Years 7 to 10 (082662E)**

Overall Level 5 NLLIA Bandscale Test; AEAS Test Score 61 – 70.

(iii) **Senior Secondary Course (004885C)**

Overall minimum NLLIA Bandscale level 5+ or IELTS 5.5 with a minimum 5.0 in any skill area).
AEAS Test Score 70+.

b) Then, following a successful enrolment interview, the offer of a full-time place at John Paul College will be made.

2. Academic Level

Direct entry Applicants are required to have completed year level comparable to the Queensland year level preceding that to which they are applying for entry (e.g. successful in a comparable Year 9 for entry into Year 10).

Comments on school reports will also be considered.

What happens when the academic entry criteria is not met

An applicant who does not meet the academic entry criteria may be considered if the student presents satisfactory results which demonstrate academic capability from a recognised test e.g. AEAS, NLLIA Band scales (please see the grid). This will be on a case by case basis.

3. Age-appropriate guidelines

- Δ Entering Year 9 The student must be less than 17 years of age
- Δ Entering Year 10 The student must be less than 18 years of age
- Δ Entering Year 11 The student must be less than 19 years of age
- Δ Entering Year 12 The student must be less than 20 years of age
