














## **Travelling Overseas**



- It is expected that when QLD hits 90% fully vaccinated
  - International travel will resume for international students
  - Incoming students must be fully vaccinated
  - Incoming students won't have to quarantine
  - Incoming students will need to have a negative PCR test before travel (72 hours)
  - You will need the International COVID-19 Certificate to enter Australia
  - You must have a valid student visa and passport to return
  - There won't be as many flights available as before COVID and they will be more expensive


BUT...things can change quickly. The decision to travel is yours. Please discuss the associated risks with your parents.



#### **COVID-19 Domestic Certificate**





#### **COVID-19 Certificate Problems**




Is there a problem with your certificate?





## QLD hitting 80% Fully Vaccinated



From 17 December 2021, unvaccinated people will be unable to:

- attend hospitality venues such as hotels, restaurants or cafes
- attend indoor entertainment venues such as theatres or cinemas
- attend outdoor entertainment activities such as sporting stadiums or theme parks
- attend Queensland Government owned galleries, museums or libraries.












#### What if I do travel?
